

Scholarship

Procedure

The Choctaw Detachment will award two scholarships annually in the amount of \$1000 each. The scholarships will be awarded at the annual officer installation and awards banquet, normally held in May. The two recipients will be selected by March 31 of each year. The scholarship may be defined as a financial grant for which no equivalent work is required. (See Qualifications and Procedures below)

Qualifications

To be qualified for this scholarship the applicant must:

- be the child or grandchild of an active member of the Choctaw Detachment (each member may sponsor 2 candidates) or be the child or grandchild of an active duty Marine or Marine Reservist who is stationed at the AFRC in Baton Rouge or be a member of the local Young Marines or be a college student who was a Young Marine for three consecutive years
- be active in activities that demonstrate leadership
- be a high school senior or undergraduate college student with an overall GPA of 2.5

Procedure

- Obtain an application packet from sponsor.
- Fill in the required forms (typewritten) with no extra pages or writing on the back of pages
- Provide a copy of the most current school transcript
- include 2 letters of recommendation with the source being one of the following: Principal, Superintendent, Counselor, Instructor, Minister, Youth Advisor, or Employer
- Ensure that sponsor fills out and signs the sponsor section of application
- Sign and date Application
